DSM-5	22 categories, 237 disorders
Symptom Categories Positive/Negative	Affective, Behavioral, Cognitive, Somatic: Not seen in healthy (+) Normal not present (-)
Etiology	Origin/cause of disorder
Prevalence	% population w/ diagnosis
Diathesis-Stress Model	Genes & env. stress interact
Biopsychosocial model	Interaction of bio, cog., s.c. factors; avoid <i>reductionism</i>
Culture & Diagnosis (DSM-5)	Syndromes, idioms of distress, perceived causes
David Rosenhan (1973) On Being Sane in Insane Places	Pseudopatients hearing voices; avg 19 days, max 52; <i>labeling</i>
Comorbidity	Multiple disorders together
Over-diagnosis / Diagnostic inflation	Pathologizing? # symptoms, severity, marketing

Psychological Disorders & Categories

Anxiety Disorders	
Specific Phobia	Object/situation causes intense irrational fear
Social Anxiety Disorder / Social Phobia	Fear of potential social judgment/evaluation

Agoraphobia	Agora: "market"; avoid public places / leaving home	
Panic attack	Sudden episode of intense fear & anxiety	
Generalized Anxiety Disorder	Less intense, persistent level of anxiety & worry	
Anxiety-Related (but have own categories)		
Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) 3+ months	Persistent stress & high arousal after trauma; flashbacks (re-living event)	
Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder (OCD)	Obsessive thoughts cause anxiety; compulsive behaviors to reduce anxiety	
Somatic Symptom & Related Disorders		
Somatic symptom disorder	Unexplained phys. symptom	
Illness anxiety disorder	Excess worry/thoughts of illness; few/no symptoms	
Conversion disorder	Perceptual/motor problem (paralysis, blindness, etc.); no physical explanation	
Dissociativ	e Disorders	
Dissociative amnesia	Loss of episodic memory	
Dissociative fugue	Loss of identity, flee & adopt new identity	
Dissociative Identity Disorder (formerly MPD)	Identity split into "alters"; prior abuse common

Autism spectrum disorder	Impaired <i>theory of mind &</i> emotional recognition

Delusion	False belief (often paranoid)	
Hallucination	False perception (hearing voices, etc.)	

Disorganized thought	Jumbled ideas; word salad	
Catatonia	Psychomotor abnormality	
Dopamine Hypothesis	Elevated levels of dopamine	
Eating Disorders		
Bulimia Nervosa Greek "ravenous hunger"	Binge & purge cycle; feelings of guilt, shame	
Anorexia Nervosa Greek "without hunger"	Very low calorie intake & fear of being fat	
Depressive Disorders		
Major Depressive Disorder 2+ weeks	Depressed mood, anhedonia (lack pleasure), fatigue, negative thinking	
Patterns of MDD	Seasonal (fall/winter) Peripartum (childbirth)	
Bipolar Disorders		
Bipolar Disorder Type I & II (less severe)	Depressive & manic episodes	
Manic episode 7+ days	Elevated energy, mood, talkativeness, impulsivity	
Personality Disorders		
Cluster A	Paranoid, Schizoid, Schizotypal	
Cluster B	Antisocial, Histrionic, Narcissistic, Borderline	
Cluster C	Dependent, Avoidant, Obsessive-Compulsive	
Neurocognitive Disorders		
Alzheimer's Disease	ACh neurons; plaque & tangled proteins; <i>dementia</i>	
Parkinson's Disease	DA neurons; mid-brain (substantia nigra), tremors	

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
